1 box band aides Latex free (optional)

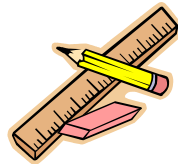
4 ounce bottle of white school glue

Set of dry erase markers (do not label)  
Package of copy paper  
Coloring book for rainy day recesses (optional)  
Six #2 plain yellow pencils (No glitter or plastic coatings)  
A backpack-large enough for snow pants in the winter  
Antibacterial wipes



## First Grade

Items will be shared in two of our first grade classrooms due to the fact that these rooms have tables. Please do not label items with your child's name. There is not enough room for students to have their own pencil boxes at their seats.

Markers (set of 8)  
Highlighter

A large eraser  
Antibacterial wipes  
A one-subject spiral notebook  
One large box of facial tissue (non-lotion please)

1 box band aides Latex free (optional)

\*pencils: plain yellow, red, blue, white, green, pink or purple with regular #2 lead - not "colored pencils" and NO glitter or plastic coatings, they don't sharpen well. Thanks!

Set of markers

1" three ring binder  
2 Large erasers or pencil tip erasers  
A one-subject notebook  
Coloring book for rainy day recess (optional)  
1 box band aides Latex free (optional)  
A backpack-large enough for snow pants in the winter

Crayons  
Set of colored pencils  
Antibacterial wipes  
Set of dry erase markers (will be used by the whole class)  
One or two large boxes of facial tissue (non-lotion please)  
At least four glue sticks - no liquid glue please  
4 packs #2 pencils (plain yellow for easy sharpening)  
Zipper pouch or plastic pencil box
